Recently my 45 year old son Adrian and I had a family trip to Limpopo Province in the impoverished area of South Africa on the border with Botswana. We visited the Sisters who are doing great work in a number of centres and I simply share with you one story.

The Holy Family Care Centre at Ofcolaco in Limpopo Province caters for over 70 orphan children, many of whom are suffering from inherited aids.

While Adrian and I were there an 11 year old orphan girl and her three siblings were brought to the centre. For several weeks she had been "mothering" her three younger siblings and they were in a very distressed state.

Immediately they arrived they were welcomed, fed, bathed and fitted with new clothes. It was transformational to witness the change in them, and quite incredible: they went from being suppressed and distraught to actually radiating joy and happiness – all because they were shown love in a practical way. This is but an example of the benefits of your generosity.
